Dear Professor Peano, As Mr Cono has told you I am preparing a book on the future of International Language. I should be most grateful for any information showing how Interlingua has put to practical use. I know that you use it for your mathematical journal. Unfortunately I cannot consult a complete file of your "Ap. I and Discussiones" because these are not at the British Museum and Mr Cono has only a few copies left, having distributed the others for propaganda. I understand Mr Cono has advised the keeper of printed books at the Museum that he should write to you for a complete set. If you would be so kind as to lend me a complete set I will either return it to you on completing my book, or deposit it a library or distribute for propaganda as you may choose. Interlingua seems to me

the best of the international languages I understand it though I do not yet write it and you may reply to me in Interlingua.
