To Prof. Peano, Turin,

Dear Sir,

I duly received your postcards of July 12<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> & also the printed matter which you have been so good as to send me.

I thank you for these. But I must explain that the movement we are initiating has not yet at all reached the stage ~~where~~ for consideration of details as to linguistic matters. We are merely doing the preliminary work of collecting opinion in favor of governmental action.

If the enclosed Declaration & circular letter have your approval I should be glad to hear whether you would incline to take up this matter for Italy, & circulate a Declaration in Italian, or whether you know of any compatriot of yours who would do so.

I have delayed answering your cards until I could send you these two enclosures.
