Dear Miss Pankhurst,

I sent Professor Peano's letter to "Time and Tide" and I understand that they will publish it next week. It was extremely easy to understand and "Interlingua" has my best wishes.

I feel sure that, as you say, a serious consideration of the question, by philologists and universities, is the only practical thing to be done - with any hope of good results. What about trying to get the Committee of Intellectual Co-operation to give a little attention to it ? The difficulty is, of course, that the members of that Committee have all their own prejudices and schemes - almost anybody interested in promoting a language of international intercourse has already joined forces with some propagandist body, so that it is as hopeless as trying to get the churches to agree.
